F-1 Student Visa Application Requirements:

- Online admissions application, including a non-refundable application fee
- Application for SEVIS Form I-20
- Housing Sponsorship Form and copy of proof of residence
- Financial Sponsorship Form and proof of finances
- Education credential evaluation
- Proof of English proficiency
- Copy of a valid passport identification page

Additional Requirements for F-1 students transferring in:

- Copy of your Form I-94 (Arrival-Departure Record)
- Copy of F-1 student visa
- Copies of all previous SEVIS Form(s) I-20
- Transfer Recommendation Form

Language Training - Intensive English Program

For students not applying for a degree program, the college offers an Intensive English Program. Students are required to submit all of the documentation above, except for proof of English proficiency.
