Promoting a Safe and Secure Learning Environment

As a way to reinforce and promote a safe and secure learning environment, Suffolk County Community College established a College-wide Multi-Disciplinary Behavior Assessment Committee (MDBAC). The MDBAC consists of faculty, administrators and staff. The primary objective of MDBAC




is to address student behaviors that may present imminent danger to themselves and/or others and to recommend standard College-wide policies and procedures to monitor and track potentially dangerous students across all three campuses and other off-campus sites.

Currently, each campus has a committee and procedures are in place to track students and increase communications between all parties – including referrals from faculty and staff.

When to Take Action...

- **If the student is exhibiting emotional difficulties and/or disturbed behavior, but is NOT an immediate threat, contact the Counseling Center.**
- **When a student is exhibiting disruptive behavior on campus, in the classroom, or at a College event, contact the Office of the Campus Associate Dean of Student Services.**
- **When a student or any individual on campus presents an imminent threat to themselves or others, call 911 and contact the Office of Public Safety.**
