Academic Placement and Advising:
The College determines academic placement by a comprehensive assessment of the student's high school or previous college transcript(s).

Register for Classes:
New students will be advised by a counselor. You will be provided with assistance in choosing your classes as well as registration instructions.

Pay Your Bill:
Tuition must be paid by the due date on your bill. Students can choose a payment plan or pay in full. If Financial Aid covers your tuition, you **MUST CONFIRM** your attendance online through your "My SCCC" or with the cashier.

Photo ID Cards / Parking Permits
Both should be obtained before classes begin. A **SCCC Photo ID Card is mandatory and must be carried at all times** while on campus. **Vehicle Registration/Parking Permits** are obtained online through the student portal (My SCCC) after you have made a payment on your bill.

10

New Student Orientation Day:
All new students will be invited to attend a Virtual New Student Orientation to prepare for the start of the semester. The Orientation program features a presentation by Peer Mentors about campus resources and a chance to network with other new students as well as staff and faculty.
