

## Prerequisite Guidelines for Non-Degree Students

- Social Sciences require the waiver of RDG099. This is satisfied by a review of college transcripts, high school transcripts, AP scores in History, or SAT evidence-based reading and writing scores.
- College transcripts showing courses with a grade of C or better will allow students to register for classes that require these courses as prerequisites.
- Advanced placement tests with scores of 3 or higher will substitute for corresponding college-level courses and can be used for satisfying prerequisite requirements for classes requiring these courses. - The following tests and scores will allow placement in college-level math courses, MAT101-MAT112:
  - SAT math score of 510 or higher
  - ACT math score of 22 or higher
  - Math B Regents score of 85 or higher
- The following tests and scores will allow placement of ENG101 Standard Freshman Composition:
  - SAT verbal score of 500 or higher
  - ACT reading score of 21 or higher
  - English Regents score of 85 or higher
- If no documentation is available for a reading, English or mathematics prerequisite, the college placement test (Accuplacer) will be administered to determine appropriate placements.
- High school transcripts with foreign language courses can be used as a guide for placement into foreign language classes. (For *Foreign Language Placement Guidelines*, see the following link: <http://depthome.sunysuffolk.edu/liminis/faculty/pdf/placetestguide.pdf>)
