Full- and partial-tuition scholarships are offered to students as they graduate from Suffolk County Community College. Individuals must demonstrate that they have contributed significantly to the College and their community, and must prove noteworthy academic achievement.

Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 3.75 (SoLI) or 3.7 (NYSPT) by the application due date, 45+ credits and must expect to graduate by the end of the current semester.

Applying for a SoLI or a NYSPT scholarship is not an application for admission to a partnering institution. You must apply for transfer admission separately and directly to the participating four-year college or university of your choice.
