### **ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship was created in honor of the late Ethel K. Cooper whose efforts “to see the good in everyone” will live on in memory of her. Through the generosity of her family, the scholarship will provide a financial award to a student engaged in a project that promotes social change or has demonstrated outstanding community service which reflects the altruistic spirit of Mrs. Cooper.

### **SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT**

Recipients are eligible to receive a **\$1000** award.

### **ELEGIBILITY**

The scholarship is open to all current part-time and full-time students of Suffolk County Community College.

### **CRITERIA**

- Applicants must submit a written proposal, no more than two (2) pages, including the following: how they have been engaged in a project that promotes social change or a description of their outstanding community service, as well as how this work has impacted them and the lives of those in their community.
- Applicants must submit a reference letter which supports their community efforts.
- Evaluation of all submissions reviewed by a scholarship committee designated by CSJHU. *Both CSJHU and the Cooper Family retain the discretion to refuse scholarships.*

### **SUBMISSION PROCESS**

- Complete the proposal coversheet attached herein.
- Narratives should not exceed two (2) pages.
- Submit coversheet and narrative as one (1) file in the form of a pdf to [csjhu@sunysuffolk.edu](mailto:csjhu@sunysuffolk.edu).
- All submissions must be received by November 30, 2021. Any applications received after such date will not be eligible.
