Applications and payment will be accepted in-person or by mail <u>only</u>. Registrar cannot process applications over the phone. Please do not send applications via email. SCCC DRIVER AND TRAFFIC SAFETY EDUCATION SUMMER 2024 PROGRAM GUIDLINES

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must be at least **16** years of age <u>and</u> obtain a **valid** learner's permit **prior** to the first day of class. The course consists of 25.5 hours of classroom instruction and 25.5 hours of in-car instruction.

XDT100: LECTURE

Students will complete 25.5 hours of **classroom** instruction. The lecture class includes assignments, quizzes and a final exam. Course materials will be provided during class.

XDT200: DRIVING

Students will complete 25.5 hours of **in-car** instruction, comprised of a 6-hour minimum of actual behind-the-wheel driving experience and an 18-hour maximum of observation **in a supervised driving school vehicle**. SCCC IS <u>NOT</u> RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING CARS FOR A STUDENT'S ROAD TEST.

PROGRAM COMPLETION

New York State Office for Driver and Traffic Safety Education (NYSDTSE) mandates that all students **MUST** complete 16 sessions of lecture *and* 16 sessions of in-car instruction in order to receive the Student Certificate of Completion MV-285, issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles. Students must receive a passing grade in both XDT100 and XDT200 in order to receive the MV-285. Students who receive this certificate will be eligible to receive their Class D License at age 17 (rather than at age 18) and may also be eligible for a rate reduction in their automobile insurance.

***MV285 certificates may take up to two weeks after the student <u>successfully completes the program</u> to be released.

Please <u>do not</u> schedule your child's road test any sooner than two weeks from the official program end date.***

LOCATION

The Summer 2024 program will be offered on the Ammerman campus in **Selden only**. Classroom locations and driving car assignments will be emailed to the parents/guardians up to one week prior to the program start date.

REGISTRATION

The completed program application form must be received *with* tuition payment of **\$675.00** (per student) no later than **June 7, 2024**. *Please be aware that classes may reach max capacity prior to this date*. Registration will be accepted on a first-come first-served basis. All applicants will **automatically** be placed in their 2nd or 3rd choice if their 1st choice is no longer available. Please plan accordingly. No changes to the students' schedules will be permitted after **June 28, 2024**.

ATTENDANCE

Our program maintains a *strict* attendance policy. The program schedule allows for only <u>one</u> absence, which *must* be made up at the end of the program (class #17). This may be used in the event of *extenuating circumstances* only. By signing this application, both student and parent/guardian commit to the <u>entire</u> schedule posted on page 4. Please review these dates carefully before submitting your registration form.

REFUNDS

Our refund policy models that of the Suffolk County Community College credit bearing courses, whereby, <u>partial</u> refunds may be issued through the third scheduled class session only. No refunds of any kind will be authorized after that time.

PARENT MEETING

We will hold a virtual informational meeting approximately one to two weeks prior to the start of classes, for registered students <u>and</u> their parents/guardians. *Further information will be emailed to all parents/guardians of registered students after the registration period is closed.*
