

PROCESS FOR APPROVING OR AMENDING THE CONSTITUTIONS FOR STUDENT PUBLICATIONS

The editorial board and faculty adviser of each student publication is responsible for developing and proposing a constitution, and/or recommending any revisions to the Campus Student Publications Board. The Campus Student Publications Board shall review the constitution and/or propose revisions and forward its recommendations regarding adoption or amendment to the senior campus student affairs administrator. The senior campus student affairs administrator shall consult with the senior college student affairs administrator, and others as deemed appropriate, in order to insure compliance with appropriate College policies. The senior campus student affairs administrator shall then notify the chairperson of the Campus Student Publications Board and the editor-in-chief and faculty adviser of the publication of his/her decision. The editorial board may appeal the senior campus student affairs administrator's decision to the College Student Publications Board.
